

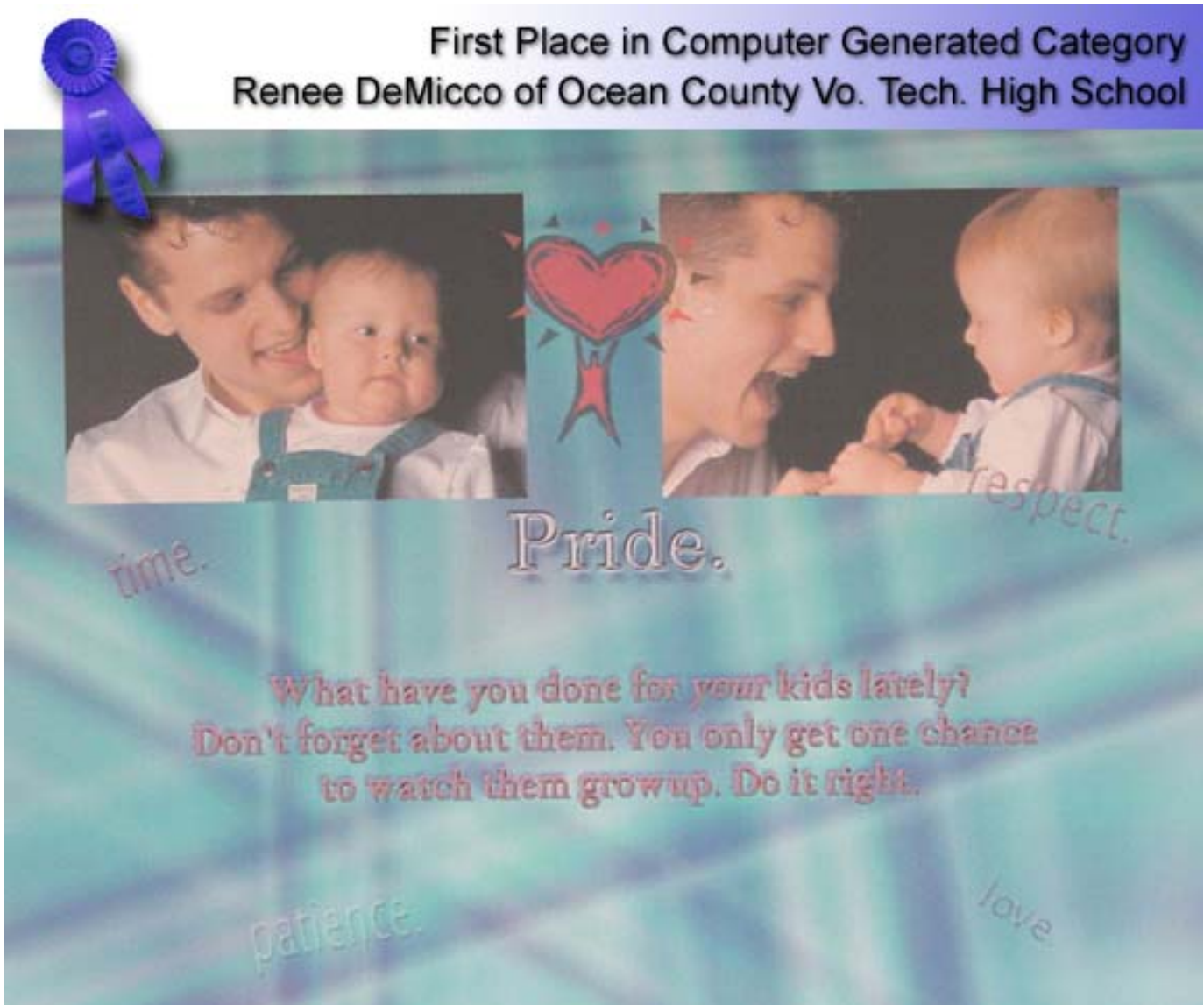


7th Annual Teen Media Contest (2002)

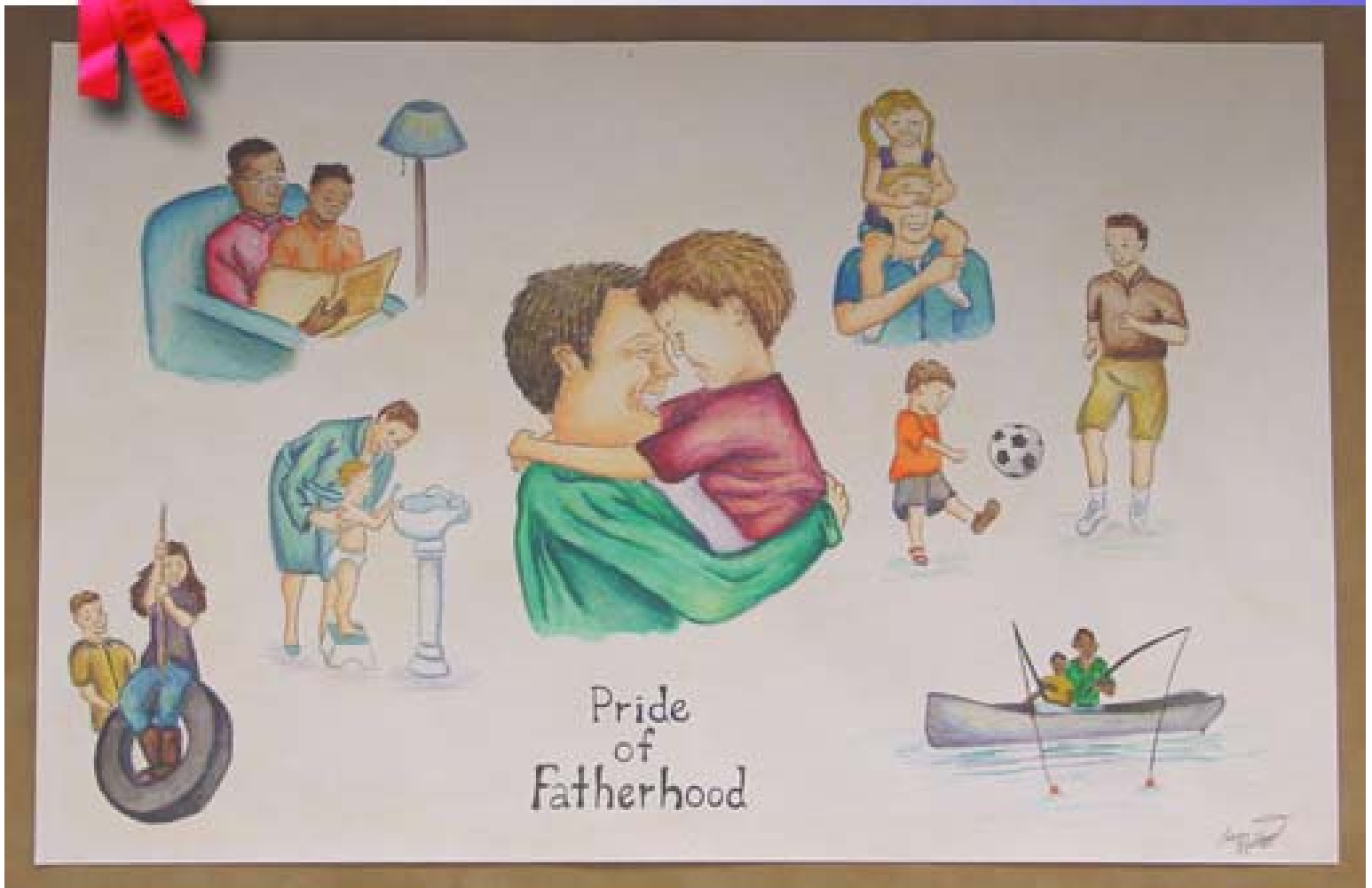
